"When I was little, I remember a teacher asking me, "What do you want to be when you grow up?" Right away, I envisioned myself drawing buildings and houses. I wanted to become an architect. That dream became real but in a different way, for God had another blueprint for my life – to help build his kingdom. Journey this Lent carrying the cross out of Love and come Easter morning you will truly be a new creation in the resurrected Lord. Nunc Coepi! Our Lady of Fatima, pray for us!
