Rebuild Holy Cross Team Meeting Minutes

Structure:

- Insulation in the attic-removal complete
- West doors/archway-best solution with least modification yet to be determined
- Ramp from ground floor level to altar level (two steps)-will get a price to build a 14' ramp with one u-turn or 90degree turn, exact design and placement to be determined. (estimate needed to submit proposal to Belleville)
- North interior wall -a simple design will be submitted to the contractor for purposes of
 price quote for integrating a "gathering space". Initial thoughts include a close replication
 of the existing north interior wall to include existing columns, interior doors, and arch
 design. A balanced use of glass could allow the space to double as a "cry room" and
 overflow seating.

Choir Loft:

• West staircase /choir loft -still to be determined. The existing staircase needs to be removed or rebuilt. There is enough room to place a bathroom in this space if the staircase is not rebuilt. This would change the footprint of the choir loft. Options include building a short set of steps to the bell rope level or removal of all steps on the west side of the choir loft. Contractor will provide a cost comparison.

Other:

- Interior and exterior doors-committee would like to refinish the existing doors.
- Sub committees
 - Organ/choir-Fr. Steven will join Rhonda Kuenstler to research and bring information to the group.
 - Seating-chairs, pews, walkers, wheelchairs, seating in gathering space-Sharon Edwards and Cindy Blank will research and bring information to the group.
 - Statues-Blessed Virgin, St. Joseph, two Jesus statues, plaques-Cathy Rudolphi and Pam Blank will research and bring information to the group.
- Staining on tile discovered. ServPro will re-clean to determine if it is permanent.

Fr. Steven will lead a "town hall" style meeting after both masses the weekend of <u>September 16</u> and <u>17</u>. This will give parishioners an opportunity to ask questions and voice opinions before any critical decisions are made.
