Joyous update to share this week! Following a recent procedure, it was determined that there was NOT a malignancy like originally thought and the cells were completely benign. Please keep Fr. Mark in your prayers as he undergoes another procedure in April to relieve pressure off the pancreas by removing more of the tumor and/or replacing stents to prevent collapse of ducts.
